

MTMO January 2007 Honduras Trip

Update for Jan. 16 – 20, 2007

Church Services Summary:

There were a total of six church services for the adults, and so many children's services we could not keep up. Children's church touched so many of the young Honduran's with the puppets and the excitement of those who worked them.



Medical Summary:

The line grew the entire day until supplies were pressed to the limited. Dr. Taylor from Portland joined another Doctor from Honduras to render medical assistance to many. We were especially touched with one young man who had a very large cut that had to be sutured, but you can see his bravery.







Construction Summary:

Today construction took off in two directions at multiple locations. The first was at Campo Nuevo. A group of eight team members went to this village to begin installation of approximately 1,600 feet of 2” water line for the improvements to the water system. This was accomplished and the existing hand pump well was prepared for removal. We also met with electricians to arrange re-building, enlarging and extending the existing electrical service to feed the new pump and water filtration system.

The second location for the construction folks was at Central Salud. Here, work continued on pouring the pad for the mechanical room under the existing tank. Also, work began internal to the clinic building on adding a drop in ceiling and insulation to keep temperatures down inside from the tin roof. The outside of a portion of the concrete building is being rendered to match the rest of the building. Windows are also being prepared to be finished out.
